<p>Introduction</p>	<p>Introduction satisfactory/a few minor tweaks. Introduction still needs work. Add content to explain importance of topic. Add current citations to support facts/statistics. Note purpose of paper for readers.</p> <p>Other comments:</p> <hr/> <hr/>
<p>Body</p>	<p>Discussion of all required elements in the paper. Many paper requirements missing – review assignment guidelines. Add discussion about _____</p> <p>Other comments:</p> <hr/> <hr/>
<p>Conclusion</p>	<p>Paper has a distinct conclusion that briefly summarizes content and reiterates the importance of the topic/research. Add a brief conclusion – the paper ends too abruptly.
